









Sample Plan of Study

Otterbein. Otterbein requires 120 credit hours to complete the bachelor's degree with an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher.

**Art Major: Students must complete two Studio Breadth electives, one ART or ARTH elective, and a concentration for this major. Concentration options include: Ceramics, Drawing, Graphic Design, Video Art, Painting, and Photography. Students choosing Painting will receive concentration credit for Columbus State Painting course(s) and will need additional Studio Breadth electives. Students with questions about concentrations and breadth options should consult with their Otterbein academic advisor. Students must earn a C or higher in all prerequisite and major course work for the Art Major (BA) at Otterbein. Classes denoted by the double asterisk are prerequisite/major courses for the Art Major (BA). Students are encouraged to meet with an Otterbein advisor regarding their major course work and general education course work meant to satisfy Otterbein's general education or INST requirement. Students must complete THREE Writing Intensive (WI) courses to graduate from Otterbein. Columbus State's Composition I course and Otterbein's ART 3000: Junior Seminar are two of the three WI courses needed for
